

Decisions Map Presentations

Rearrange desks as directed by teacher (8 desks in a rectangle formation)

RULES: Have someone in your group read the following rules before starting the presentations.

- No side conversations when someone is presenting
- Save any questions you may have for the person presenting for the end
- Be respectful
- If there is an event on your decisions map that you do not want to share because it is too personal, skip that event.

How presentations are done:

1. Each person will present their decisions map to the group.
 - a. First introduce yourself
 - b. Second, read off your values
 - c. Third, explain the 8 events you placed on your map
 - d. Fourth, Read the goals you want to accomplish in 10 years
 - e. Finally, ask your group if anyone has questions.
 - f. Next person
